

RESOLUTION NO. 25-17

A RESOLUTION REGARDING TIM LEMONS AND CITY SIDEWALK PROJECT
CONNECTING THE DREW COUNTY LIBRARY TO JORDAN PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Monticello contracted with Tim Lemon's engineering for engineering work on the above mentioned sidewalk project on or about 05-27-20;

WHEREAS, An ARDOT 2020 Tap Grant in the amount of \$200,000.00 has been awarded to be used toward this project;

WHEREAS, the engineering services required to bring this contract to bid and ultimately to completion have failed to be completed;

WHEREAS, the Mayor has made numerous requests for updates and communication and otherwise encouraged the completion of this project, all without success;

WHEREAS, the Monticello City Council agrees that this project must be completed, or the City's relationship with Tim Lemon's Engineering be ended and appropriate efforts be made to make the City whole in regard to funds paid to Tim Lemon's Engineering.

It is, therefore, by the Monticello City Council resolved as follows:

1. That within thirty days of the date of this meeting, Tim Lemon's Engineering will complete the required tasks needed to bring this City Sidewalk Project to bid or, failing that, Tim


Lemon's Engineering is determined to be in breach of the contract with the City of Monticello, the contract is to be terminated, and appropriate legal recourse against Tim Lemons should be taken.

It is so resolved.
