

ORDINANCE NO. 849

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 522, 776, 825, 838 and 840 AS SEQUENTLY AMENDED, FIXING RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF MONTICELLO, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Monticello, Arkansas as follows:

Ordinance No. 522 of the City of Monticello, adopted December 05, 1974, as previously amended, shall be further amended to read as follows:

Section 1: That the following monthly rates shall be fixed to be charged for services to be furnished by the solid waste management system of the City of Monticello, which the Council finds a reasonable and necessary rate to be charged:

- A. \$18.00 for one (1) pickup per week from each single-family residence, each unit of a duplex (charged per unit), each unit of an apartment house or complex (charged per unit) whether utilizing a cart (96 gallons) or a dumpster (8, 6 or 4 yards);
- B. \$18.00 for one (1) pickup per week from each commercial unit that utilizes a cart (96 gallons);
- C. \$70.00 for one pick up per week for each 8- or 6-yard dumpster and \$70.00 for two pick-ups per week for a 4-yard dumpster from each commercial establishment;
- D. Provided that if the commercial dumpster consumer requests additional days in the weekly schedule and/or the weekly volume of solid waste of a unit is high enough to justify such action, the monthly rate will be \$70.00 multiplied by the number of days requested per week (i.e. A store with an 8 yard dumpster is picked up three times per week, the monthly rate will be $\$70.00 * 3 = \210.00);
- E. Any extra dumpster pickups requested by the consumer that are not on the weekly schedule shall be charged \$35.00 per pickup regardless of the size of the dumpster.


Section 2. Repealer. That all ordinances, or parts thereof, currently in effect within the City of Monticello in conflict herewith shall be deemed to be amended or repealed by this ordinance to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. Annual Review. The rates will be reviewed annually by the City Council before the end of each fiscal year.

Section 4. Emergency Clause. The City Council hereby determines that the necessity for removal of solid waste from the City is essential to the preservation of the public health and safety of the citizens of Monticello; and that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary to serve the public good; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
